Muni operates buses, historic streetcars, light rail vehicles and cable cars. Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) links San Francisco with nearby counties and SFO. BART and Muni tickets may be purchased at kiosks within each station, as well as through the MuniMobile app. Muni tickets may be purchased with exact cash only from Muni drivers. Children ages four and under ride free.

A lively entertainment district, the Fillmore is frequented by jazz, blues and rock-and-roll luminaries. Also a desirable shopping destination, designer and one-of-a-kind boutiques line Fillmore St. for blocks north of Geary Blvd. Iconic concert venues, historic jazz and cabaret clubs are among some of San Francisco's classic bars and restaurants. The Fillmore shares a rich cross culture with the adjacent Japantown, the oldest of three remaining Japantowns in the U.S.
